

ORDINANCE NO. 1-2012

**TITLE: APPROPRIATION
 COAF SEIBERLING OFFICE ABATEMENT**

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$387,626 FROM THE UNAPPROPRIATED ITEM OF THE CITY GRANT FUND TO THE CITY GRANT FUND OPERATING BUDGET, DUE TO A GRANT FROM THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF DEVELOPMENT’S OFFICE OF REDEVELOPMENT, FOR THE COAF SEIBERLING OFFICE ABATEMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the sum of Three Hundred Eighty Seven Thousand Six Hundred Twenty Six Dollars and No Cents (\$387,626.00) is hereby appropriated from the Unappropriated Item of the City Grant Fund to the City Grant Fund Operating Budget, due to a grant from the Ohio Department of Development’s Office of Redevelopment, to be used for asbestos abatement, lamps/ballast removal, general waste disposal, project management and coordination, update Phase 1 property assessment oversight, prepare NFA documents and the NFA fee for the COAF Seiberling Office Abatement.

SECTION 2. That the Director of Finance is hereby directed to draw his warrants in payment thereof.

SECTION 3. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, in order to utilize the grant funds in a timely manner, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
