ORDINANCE NO. 1-2013

**TITLE: ENTER INTO CONTRACT – REPUBLIC WASTE SERVICES
“REFUSE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL PROGRAM”**

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A FIVE (5) YEAR CONTRACT WITH REPUBLIC WASTE SERVICES, THE LOWEST AND/OR BEST BIDDER, TO PROVIDE THE WEEKLY RESIDENTIAL CURBSIDE GARBAGE/RECYCLING COLLECTION FOR THE CITY OF BARBERTON, EFFECTIVE MARCH 1, 2013, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a five-year contract with Republic Waste Services, the “lowest and/or best” bidder, as determined and awarded by the Board of Control, beginning March 1, 2013, to provide the weekly Residential Curbside Garbage/Recycling Collection for the City of Barberton and to execute certain work and to provide services as described in the contract, together with such revisions and additions as are approved by the Mayor or Director of Law as being consistent with the objectives of this ordinance.

SECTION 2. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, in order that the contract go into effect as soon as possible due to the existing contract expiring on February 28, 2013, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
