TITLE: SUBMIT GRANT APPLICATION US EPA

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION BY THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO THE US EPA, TO APPLY FOR AN EPA AIR QUALITY GRANT TO ASSIST IN THE PURCHASE OF NEW TIER 4 COMPLIANT DIESEL ENGINE VEHICLES FOR THE STREETS, STORMWATER, AND PARKS DEPARTMENTS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the grant will allow the City up to a 20% reimbursement of the cost of replacing vehicles with older diesel engines with new vehicles or engine retrofits.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That Council hereby approves the submission of a grant application by the Director of Public Service to the US EPA, in order to apply for an EPA Air Quality Grant to assist in the purchase of new Tier 4 Compliant Diesel Engine Vehicles, for the Streets, Stormwater, and Parks Departments.

SECTION 2. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 3. That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, for the reason that time is of the essence due to an application deadline, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
