AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 38-2013

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 38-2013 THAT APPROVED THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION BY THE PARKS AND RECREATION'S BEAUTIFICATION DEPARTMENT FOR THE 2013 COMMUNITY RECYCLING ACCESS GRANT FROM THE SUMMIT/AKRON SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT AUTHORITY, BY INCREASING THE AMOUNT TO \$21,760.14, FOR BARBERTON'S UPCOMING RECYCLING PROGRAM, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That Council hereby amends Ordinance No. 38-2013 that approved the submission of a grant application by the Parks and Recreation's Beautification Department, for the 2013 Community Recycling Access Grant from the Summit/Akron Solid Waste Management Authority, by increasing the amount to Twenty One Thousand Seven Hundred Sixty Dollars and Fourteen Cents (\$21,760.14), due to an increase in available funds, for Barberton's upcoming recycling program. No match is required from the City for this grant and the funding amount is determined by population.

SECTION 2. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, for the reason that time is of the essence due to an application deadline, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
