ORDINANCE NO. 47-2012

TITLE: ENTER INTO CONTRACT – HUMAN RESOURCES EMPLOYEE LIFE INSURANCE

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A RENEWAL CONTRACT DUE TO EXPIRE ON MARCH 31, 2012, WITH LINCOLN FINANCIAL, THE LOWEST AND/OR BEST BIDDER, FOR LIFE INSURANCE FOR CITY EMPLOYEES, FROM APRIL 1, 2012 THROUGH APRIL 1, 2014, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a renewal contract due to expire on March 31, 2012, with Lincoln Financial, the "lowest and/or best" bidder as determined by the Administration, for life insurance for city employees, from April 1, 2012 through April 1, 2014.

SECTION 2. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, for the reason that time is of the essence due to the expiration of the current policy on March 31, 2012, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
