

ORDINANCE NO. 54-2013

**TITLE: REPEAL OF ORDINANCE NO. 44-2013
ADOPT NEW ORDINANCE FOR LIFE INSURANCE**

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 44-2013, “ENTER INTO CONTRACT – HUMAN RESOURCES – EMPLOYEE LIFE INSURANCE”; AND ENACTING A NEW ORDINANCE TO ENTER INTO A THREE-YEAR CONTRACT WITH *THE STANDARD* (LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY) TO PROVIDE LIFE INSURANCE FOR CITY EMPLOYEES AND RETIRED EMPLOYEES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That Ordinance No. 44-2013, “Enter into Contract – Human Resources – Employee Life Insurance,” be repealed.

SECTION 2. That Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to enter into a three year contract with The Standard, to provide life insurance for city employees and retired employees.

SECTION 3. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, in order to enter into contract as soon as possible, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
