TITLE: DEDICATION – NEW HAVEN PHASE I, IIA AND IIB

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BARBERTON ACCEPTING THE DEDICATION OF ALL ROADS IN NEW HAVEN PHASE I, IIA AND IIB.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 32-2003, adopted on March 24, 2003, dedicated five (5) streets and five (5) alleys in the New Haven – Phase I area; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 87-2006, adopted on May 22, 2006, dedicated four (4) streets in the New Haven Phase 2A allotment; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 133-2008, adopted on July 14, 2008, changed the name of Monroe Alley to Krska Place.

WHEREAS, it is intended to incorporate all portions of the assumed dedication in one piece of legislation as the boundaries of the original development as well as changes to street names have occurred.

NOW, THEREOFRE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That Council hereby accepts the dedication of all roads in New Haven Phase I, IIA & IIB which includes the following: Hoffman Place, Frederick Street from Himelrigh Alley to Bishop Oval, Miller Street from Himelrigh Alley to Bishop Oval, Himelrigh Boulevard from Fairland Road to Miller Street, Monroe Square East, Bishop Oval from Fairland to Monroe Square East, Lauter Avenue East, Himelrigh Alley South, Himelrigh Alley North, Frederick Alley West, Frederick Alley East, Krska Place and South Monroe Alley.

SECTION 2. That is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
