

ORDINANCE NO. 63-2013

TITLE: TRANSFER OF FUNDS – LAW DEPARTMENT

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A TRANSFER OF AN APPROPRIATION OF \$2,600.00 FROM THE LAW DEPARTMENT’S OPERATING COST BUDGET TO THE LAW DEPARTMENT’S PERSONAL SERVICES BUDGET, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the sum of Two Thousand Six Hundred Dollars and No Cents (\$2,600.00) is hereby authorized from a transfer of an appropriation from the Law Department’s Operating Cost Budget to the Law Department’s Personal Services Budget to have coverage while an employee is on an extended absence. Coverage will begin May 1, 2013 for four (4) weeks (160 hours at \$13.50 per hour, plus benefits).

SECTION 2. That the Director of Finance is hereby directed to draw his warrants in payment thereof.

SECTION 3. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, and for the reason that the funds are needed as soon as possible in order to have the funding available by May 1, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
