TITLE: PURCHASE OF CRUISERS
GSA AUTO CHOICE SYSTEM
POLICE DEPARTMENT

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT WITH GSA AUTO CHOICE SYSTEM, TO PURCHASE TWO (2) 2013 FORD POLICE INTERCEPTOR SEDANS, FOR THE COST OF \$23,637.03 EACH, PLUS \$16,000 TO INCLUDE THE MOUNTINGS OF MDT SYSTEMS AND ADDITIONAL EQUIPMENT FOR BOTH VEHICLES, PURSUANT TO ORDINANCE NO. 42-1995, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That Council hereby authorizes the Mayor, or his designee, to enter into contract with GSA Auto Choice System (a cooperative purchasing program through the Ohio Department of Public Safety), to purchase two (2) 2013 Ford Police Interceptor Sedans, for the cost of Twenty Three Thousand Six Hundred Thirty Seven Dollars and Three Cents (\$23,637.03) each, plus Sixteen Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$16,000.00) to include the mountings of MDT Systems and additional equipment for both vehicles, pursuant to Ordinance No. 42-1995. By virtue of the Director's participation in the GSA Auto Choice System and Ohio Revised Code, said purchases are hereby authorized to be made without competitive bidding.

SECTION 2. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, to be able to take delivery of these vehicles as soon as possible, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
