ORDINANCE NO. 77-2013

TITLE: AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 142-2012 TO INCLUDE ITEMS THAT WERE NOT PRESENT AT THE TIME OF THE ORIGINAL AGREEMENT

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER AN AMENDMENT TO AN AGREEMENT TO CREATE A JOINT DISPATCH CENTER WITH THE CITY OF NORTON AND COPLEY TOWNSHIP, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City, Copley Township and the City of Norton (collectively, the "Cooperative Parties") previously entered into a Joint Dispatch Pilot Project Memorandum of Understand effective January 12, 2009 as a pilot program for combining the public safety dispatch centers of the Cooperative Parties; and

WHEREAS, a Cooperative Parties have applied for and receive a \$300,000 Local Government Innovation Fund loan to pay the costs of combining the dispatch centers for the Cooperative Parties; and

WHEREAS, the Cooperative Parties entered into an Agreement between the Cities of Barberton, Norton and the Township of Copley for the Purpose of Creating a Shared Public Safety Dispatch Center dated September 24, 2012 (the "Original Agreement") to jointly manage the planning, designing, construction and completion of a new, shared public safety dispatch center (the "Dispatch Center") to service the Cooperative Parties;

WHEREAS, the Cooperative Parties entered into an Agreement dated November 19, 2012 to create a regional council of governments pursuant to Chapter 167 of the Ohio Revised Code named the Southwest Summit council of Governments for the purpose of sharing services, including management and operation of the Dispatch Center;

WHEREAS, the Cooperative Parties now desire to amend the Original Agreement by executing and delivering the amended Agreement between the Cities of Barberton, Norton, and the Township of Copley for the Purpose of Creating a Shared Public Safety Dispatch Center in the form attached as **Exhibit A** hereto (the "Amended Agreement") to provide for additional terms and conditions pursuant which the Cooperative Parties will operate and manage the Dispatch Center.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. This Council hereby authorizes the Mayor or his designee to execute and deliver the Amended Agreement in the form attached hereto as Exhibit A, together with such changes as shall be approved by the Mayor and shall not be adverse to the City, which approval shall be conclusively evidenced by the execution thereof by the Mayor or his designee.

SECTION 2. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, for the reason that time is of the essence due to time constraints in the development process of this project, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
