A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BARBERTON TO HONOR AND GIVE PUBLIC RECOGNITION TO RONALD J. SPECK FOR GIVING THE CITY AND ITS CITIZENS OVER 32 YEARS OF DEDICATED AND OUTSTANDING SERVICE.
