## **ORDINANCE NO. 89-2012**

## REPEAL OF ORDINANCE NO. 39-2012 AMENDING BARBERTON CODIFIED ORDINANCES CHAPTER 672 – WEAPONS AND EXPLOSIVES

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BARBERTON REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 39-2012, "AMENDING BARBERTON CODIFIED ORDINANCES – CHAPTER 672 – WEAPONS AND EXPLOSIVES," THAT AMENDED SECTION 672.01 (DEFINITIONS) AND ADDED SECTION 672.09 (UNLAWFUL TRANSACTIONS IN WEAPONS), AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

**WHEREAS,** Barberton City Council passed Ordinance No. 39-2012 on March 12, 2012; and

**WHEREAS,** a zoning ordinance, Ordinance No. 60-2012, was then passed on April 23, 2012 setting forth the zoning requirements for the sale of weapons.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

**SECTION 1**. That Council hereby repeals Ordinance No. 39-2012, "Amending Barberton Codified Ordinances – Chapter 672 – Weapons and Explosives," an ordinance that amended Section 672.01 (Definitions) and added Section 672.09 (Unlawful Transactions in Weapons).

**SECTION 3**. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

**SECTION 4**. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, and that it concerns the efficient operation of the City, for the reason that the Ordinance be repealed as soon as possible, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall, therefore, be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
