TITLE: DISPOSAL OF VEHICLES POLICE DEPARTMENT

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE POLICE **CHIEF** TO SCRAP/SALVAGE TWENTY-SEVEN (27) VEHICLES DEEMED TO BE NO LONGER NEEDED FOR ANY MUNICIPAL PURPOSE AND UNFIT AND UNSAFE FOR DISPOSAL IN ANY OTHER MANNER, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:
