TITLE: SUPPORT – APPLICATION
OHIO EPA 319 SURFACE WATER IMPROVEMENT GRANT

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE CITY OF BARBERTON FILING AN APPLICATION TO APPLY FOR THE OHIO EPA 319 SURFACE WATER IMPROVEMENT GRANT, IN ORDER TO OBTAIN UP TO \$250,000 FOR STORMWATER QUALITY AND QUANTITY IMPROVEMENTS TO THE MUNICIPAL BUILDING PARKING LOT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, to increase the quality of stormwater runoff from the Barberton Municipal Parking Lot to Lake Anna; and

WHEREAS, improvements for Stormwater quality will be combined to reduce peak stormwater discharges to aid in minimizing flood potential for the Barberton Police Department facility.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That this Council hereby acknowledges and supports the City of Barberton filing an application to apply for the Ohio EPA 319 Surface Water Improvement Grant, in order to obtain up to \$250,000 for Stormwater Quality and Quantity Improvements to the Municipal Building Parking Lot. The City financial match for the Grant will come from the Stormwater Utility Capital Improvement Fund and in-kind service from the City staff.

SECTION 2. That the City of Barberton hereby understands and agrees that participation in the program will require compliance with program guidelines and assurances and compliance with local and state laws and codes associated with this project.

SECTION 3. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 4. That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, for the reason that the grant application deadline is June 1, 2012, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
