TITLE: ENTER INTO CONTRACT – ODOT BRIDGE INSPECTION PROGRAM

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BARBERTON AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (ODOT) FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF THE INTERSECTION LOCATED AT WOOSTER ROAD NORTH / WEST HOPOCAN AVENUE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

SECTION 1. Project Description.

WHEREAS, the City of Barberton has identified the need for the described project:

Bridge Inspection Program Services, including, but not limited to bridge load rating calculations, scour assessments, bridge inspections, and fracture critical plan development.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City of Barberton of Summit County, Ohio.

SECTION 2. Consent Statement.

Being in the public interest, the City of Barberton gives consent to the Director of Transportation to complete the above described project.

SECTION 3. Cooperation Statement.

The City of Barberton shall cooperate with the Director of Transportation in the above described project as follows:

The State shall assume and bear 100% of all of the cost for Bridge Inspection Program Services requested by the City and agreed to by the State. Eligible Bridge Inspection Services are described in the Consultant's Scope of Services Task Order Contract (Exhibit A).

The City of Barberton agrees to pay 100% of the cost of those features which are not included in Exhibit A.

SECTION 4. <u>Utilities and Right-of-Way Statement</u>.

The City of Barberton agrees that all right-of-right required for the described project will be made available in accordance with current State and Federal regulations.

SECTION 5. Authority to Sign

The Mayor of said City of Barberton is hereby empowered on behalf of the City of Barberton to enter into contracts with the Director of Transportation which is necessary to complete the above described project.

SECTION 6. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 7. That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience

and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, in order to expedite the highway project and to promote highway safety, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
