RESOLUTION NO. 102-2013

TITLE: ENTER INTO PARTNERSHIP OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION (OPWC) AND SUMMIT COUNTY

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO APPLY FOR FUNDING AND ENTER INTO PARTNERSHIP WITH OPWC AND SUMMIT COUNTY FOR THE WIDENING OF 31ST STREET FROM WOOSTER ROAD TO SHANNON AVENUE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the County Engineer concludes that there is a public safety need to improve 31st Street, designated as the 31st Street Widening and Traffic Control Project ("Project"), in the City of Barberton, in Council District 7; and

WHEREAS, the City of Barberton is eligible to acquire Ohio Public Works Commission Local Transportation Improvement Program ("LTIP") grant funds for the Project; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to apply for OPWC funding and if successful, directed to enter into a partnership agreement with Ohio Public Works Commission and Summit County for the widening of 31st Street from Wooster Road to Shannon Avenue.

SECTION 2. That if successful, the \$700,000.00 local share would be split three ways:

A.	County of Summit	\$ 50,000.00
B.	City of Barberton	\$325,000.00
C.	OPWC	\$325,000.00

SECTION 3. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 4. That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, in order to provide road safety improvements, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
