

ORDINANCE NO. 102-2019

**TITLE: ENTER INTO CONTRACT
BLUE TECHNOLOGIES, INC.**

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE BARBERTON MUNICIPAL CLERK OF COURTS TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH BLUE TECHNOLOGIES, INC., WITHOUT COMPETITIVE BIDDING BEING A SOLE SOURCE PROVIDER, IN THE SUM OF \$70,527.64 FOR THE PURCHASE, INSTALLATION AND CONFIGURING OF OnBASE DOCUMENT MANAGING SOFTWARE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, funding is provided through the Ohio Supreme Court 2019 Technology Grant award dated April 12, 2019 as well as budgeted funds in the Court of Clerk Computer Special Project Funds; and

WHEREAS, the City of Barberton currently utilizes OnBase in other departments and expansion to the probation department will streamline workflow and move the department towards a paperless work environment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Barberton Municipal Clerk of Courts is authorized to enter into contract without formal bidding and advertising with Blue Technologies, Inc. for the purchase, installation and configuring of OnBase document managing software in the sum of Seventy Thousand, Five Hundred Twenty-Seven Dollars and Sixty-Four Cents (\$70,527.64).

SECTION 2. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 3. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, in order for execution to occur in a timely fashion, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
