TITLE: ENTER INTO CONTRACT – WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT STORMWATER MANAGEMENT PROJECT

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT WITH KENMORE CONSTRUCTION COMPANY, INC., THE LOWEST AND/OR BEST BIDDER, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$42,882.00, FOR THE STORMWATER CONTAINMENT REQUIREMENTS AS REQUIRED BY THE OEPA FOR THE WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Director of Public Service is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Kenmore Construction Company, Inc., the "lowest and/or best" bidder as recommended by the Utilities Director, in the amount of Forty Two Thousand Eight Hundred Eighty Two Dollars and No Cents (\$42,882.00) for the Stormwater containment requirements as required by the OEPA.

SECTION 2. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, in order that the project continue in a timely manner, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
