ORDINANCE NO. 104-2012

TITLE: ENTER INTO USER AGREEMENT –
GOV DEALS ONLINE SURPLUS AUCTIONS

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE JUDGES OF THE BARBERTON MUNICIPAL COURT, OR THEIR DESIGNEE, TO ENTER INTO A USER AGREEMENT WITH GOV DEALS ONLINE SURPLUS AUCTIONS, TO SELL BY AUCTION ONLINE AND TO DISPOSE OF EQUIPMENT AND/OR PROPERTY THE JUDGES DEEM TO BE NO LONGER NEEDED FOR ANY MUNICIPAL PURPOSE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Judges of the Barberton Municipal Court, or their designee, is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a User Agreement with GovDeals Online Surplus Auctions, to sell by auction online and to dispose of equipment and/or property the Judges deem to be no longer needed for any municipal purpose and/or legally authorized to be disposed of, without appraisal and to the highest bidder for cash.

SECTION 2. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, for the reason that preparations need to be made to expedite the auction as soon as possible, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
