## **RESOLUTION NO. 109-2013**

## TITLE: OPWC FUNDING APPLICATION WADSWORTH/SUMMIT ROAD SANITARY SEWER EXTENSION

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF BARBERTON TO APPLY FOR FUNDING WITH THE OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION, FOR THE WADSWORTH / SUMMIT ROAD SANITARY SEWER EXTENSION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

**WHEREAS**, the funding is available from the State of Ohio Public Works Commission (OPWC) as engineered by Environmental Design Group (EDG) and approved by the agency; and

**WHEREAS**, the existing backwash water treatment system at the Water Treatment Plant is in need of replacement, and;

**WHEREAS,** a 12-inch sanitary sewer should be extended north to the WTP from the existing Barber Road Trunk Sewer approximately 1,700 feet, thereby, providing better and more cost effective wastewater disposal, and;

WHEREAS, both Barberton and Norton agree to share in the cost of design and construction, and;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

- **SECTION 1.** That Council hereby authorizes the Mayor or his designee to sign all documents on behalf of the City.
- **SECTION 2.** That the Council further authorizes the Mayor to enter into any agreements as may be necessary and appropriate for obtaining this financial assistance.
- **SECTION 3.** That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.
- **SECTION 4.** That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, for the reason that time is of the essence due to an application deadline, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
