TITLE: COMMENDATION - CAPTAIN MICHAEL CORLL

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BARBERTON TO HONOR AND GIVE PUBLIC RECOGNITION TO CAPTAIN MICHAEL CORLL FOR HIS 28 YEARS OF DEDICATED SERVICE TO THE CITY OF BARBERTON FIRE DEPARTMENT AND TO THIS COMMUNITY.

WHEREAS, Michael J. Corll was hired as a Barberton Firefighter on February 20, 1995. He was promoted to Lieutenant on April 17, 2003 and Captain on May 11, 2018; and

WHEREAS, during his service to the Fire Department and City, Captain Corll set-up and organized the Public Education Program with the Barberton City Schools in 1997, participated in the Juvenile Firestopper Program through Akron Children’s Hospital, was a member of the Barberton Red Cross (President of the Board for 2 years) and took over the fire department hose inventory program; and

WHEREAS, Capt. Corll received numerous awards which include the 1999 “Service Above Self” award from the Barberton Rotary Club and in 2001 received the “Circle of Friends” award from the Barberton Education Association; and

WHEREAS, Capt. Corll retired from the Barberton Fire Department on February 22, 2023; and

WHEREAS, Capt. Corll loves to vacation with his family - wife Erin, stepson Nicholas, stepdaughter Madeline, and a dog named Charlie; and

WHEREAS, this Council, along with the Administration, the Barberton Fire Department and citizens, wish Mike health, happiness for years to come!

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Council of the City of Barberton hereby honors and gives public recognition to Capt. Michael Corll for his 28 years of dedicated service to the Barberton Fire Department and to this community.

SECTION 2.
