TITLE: ENTER INTO CONTRACT KENWORTH OF RICHFIELD

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT WITH KENWORTH OF RICHFIELD, FOR THE PURCHASE OF A DUMP TRUCK AT THE COST OF \$81,659, THROUGH THE OHIO STATE COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM, PURSUANT TO ORDINANCE NO. 42-1995, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That Council hereby authorized the Mayor, or his designee, to enter into contract with Kenworth of Richfield, for the purchase of a Dump Truck, at the cost of Eighty-One Thousand Six Hundred Fifty Nine Dollars and No Cents (\$81,659.00), through the Ohio State Cooperative Purchasing Program, pursuant to Ordinance No. 42-1995. By virtue of the Mayor's participation in the Ohio State Cooperative Purchasing Program and Ohio Revised Code, said purchase is hereby authorized to be made without competitive bidding.

SECTION 2. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, as the truck has custom specifications that need to be addressed, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
