ORDINANCE NO. 113-2013

TITLE: ENTER INTO CONTRACT LYTLE CONSTRUCTION

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT WITH LYTLE CONSTRUCTION, THE ONLY BIDDER, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$204,346.20, FOR THE COLUMBIA HEIGHTS PAVING PROGRAM, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to enter into contract with Lytle Construction, the only bidder as determined and awarded by the Board of Control, in the amount of Two Hundred Four Thousand Three Hundred Forty Six Dollars and Twenty Cents (\$204,346.20), for the Columbia Heights Paving Program.

SECTION 2. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, in order for the paving to facilitate federal timeliness, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
