

ORDINANCE NO. 113-2015

**TITLE: ENTER INTO CONTRACT – STREETS
KENMORE CONSTRUCTION**

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT WITH KENMORE CONSTRUCTION COMPANY, INC., THE LOWEST AND/OR BEST BIDDER, IN AN AMOUNT OF \$306,620 FOR THE ASPHALT RESURFACING OF ADDITIONAL STREETS UNDER THE 2015 STREET / ROAD PAVING PROGRAM, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor, or his designee, is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Kenmore Construction Company, in an amount of Three Hundred Six Thousand Six Hundred Twenty Dollars and No Cents (\$306,620.00), for the asphalt resurfacing of additional streets under the 2015 Street / Road Paving Program.

SECTION 2. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, in order that timing is important, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
