ORDINANCE NO. 113-2016

**TITLE: AMEND BARBERTON CODIFIED ORDINANCES
CHAPTER 844 – PEDDLERS AND SOLICITORS**

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 844, SECTION 844.04(f) “PEDDLERS AND SOLICITORS,” OF THE BARBERTON CODIFIED ORDINANCES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 844, Section 844.04 (f) of the Barberton Codified Ordinances entitled “Peddlers and Solicitors,” shall be amended by including said amendment in **bold** to read as follows:

- (f) Any person who through the solicitation permitting process is discovered to have been convicted of, or who has plead guilty to any criminal offense of the Ohio Revised Code, United States Code, or any other substantially similar state or local code provisions that constitutes any theft or fraud offense, any offense of burglary, any offenses of violence, **any drug trafficking offense** or any offenses of any sex crime law or statute, is prohibited from commercial solicitation within the City of Barberton.

SECTION 2. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, for the reason that it is necessary to facilitate timeliness of adding to the registration/licensing process, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
