TITLE: TRANSFER / APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS STORM WATER VEHICLE

AN ORDINANCE TRANSFERRING \$5,471.60 FROM THE SERVICE DIRECTORS CAPITAL BUDGET TO THE GENERAL FUND TRANSFER BUDGET AND TRANSFERRING SAID AMOUNT FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO THE STORM WATER IMPROVEMENT FUND AND APPROPRIATING SAID AMOUNT FROM THE UNAPPROPRIATED ITEM OF THE STORM WATER IMPROVEMENT FUND TO THE STORM WATER IMPROVEMENT FUND TO THE STORM WATER IMPROVEMENT FUND TO THE UTILIZATION OF A STORM WATER VEHICLE BY THE SERVICE DIRECTOR / BUILDING DEPARTMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the total amount of Five Thousand Four Hundred Seventy-One Dollars and Sixty Cents (\$5,471.60) be transferred from the Capital Line Item of the Service Director's Budget to the Transfer Out Line Item of the General Fund and that said amount be appropriated from the General Fund to the Storm Water Fund for the utilization of a storm water vehicle by the service director / building department.

SECTION 2. That the Director of Finance is hereby directed to draw his warrants in payment thereof.

SECTION 3. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 4. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, for the reason that the transfer/appropriation take place as soon as possible in order to proceed with this project, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
