AN ORDINANCE TO ADOPT THE "2014/2015 SUMMIT COUNTY INTERGOVERNMENTAL MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING FOR JOB CREATION AND RETENTION AND TAX REVENUE SHARING"; AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AGREEMENT WITH THE COUNTY OF SUMMIT AND THE COMMUNITIES THAT ARE SIGNATORIES TO THE ATTACHED AGREEMENT ENTITLED "SUMMIT COUNTY INTERGOVERNMENTAL MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING FOR JOB CREATION AND RETENTION AND TAX REVENUE SHARING," EXPRESSING A MUTUAL DESIRE TO RETAIN AND ATTRACT BUSINESSES AND JOBS AS OUTLINED IN SAID AGREEMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the original "Summit County Intergovernmental Memorandum of Understanding for Job Creation and Retention and Tax Revenue Sharing" Agreement was entered into in December 2008 (Ord. No. 234-2008) and was then amended in June 2010 (Ord. No. 88-2010), May 2011 (Ord. No. 66-2011) and in June 2012 (Ord. No. 101-2012.)

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with the County of Summit and the communities that are signatories to the Attached Agreement entitled "Summit County Intergovernmental Memorandum of Understanding for Job Creation and Retention and Tax Revenue Sharing," expressing a mutual desire to retain and attract businesses as outlined in said Agreement, effective October 1, 2014 through June 30, 2015.

SECTION 2. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, in order that this Agreement is processed as soon as possible, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
