

ORDINANCE NO. 116-2019

TITLE: APPROPRIATION - LAW DEPARTMENT

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$7,996.81 FROM THE UNAPPROPRIATED ITEM OF THE GENERAL FUND TO THE LAW DEPARTMENT OPERATING BUDGET, DUE TO A REIMBURSEMENT FROM THE TRAVELERS INSURANCE COMPANY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, this is for the cost of defending two (2) Ohio Civil Rights Commission Complaints and our policy required us to pay defense cost and then apply for reimbursement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the sum of Seven Thousand Nine Hundred Ninety-Six Dollars and Eighty-One Cents (\$7,996.81) is hereby appropriated from the Unappropriated Item of the General Fund to the Law Department Operating Budget.

SECTION 2. That the Director of Finance is hereby directed to draw his warrants in payment thereof.

SECTION 3. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 4. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, for the reason that this money can be replaced in the budget as soon as possible, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
