TITLE: BARBERTON CODIFIED ORDINANCES CHAPTER 206 – WARDS AND BOUNDARIES

A RESOLUTION ACKNOWLEDGING THE DECENNIAL CENSUS SURVEY RESULTS FOR 2022 PROVIDED BY THE UNITED STATES CENSUS BUREAU AND ACCEPTING THE CURRENT WARD BOUNDARIES AS SUFFICIENT AND THAT NO MODIFICATION TO CHAPTER 206 OF THE BARBERTON CODIFIED ORDINANCES IS REQUIRED.

WHEREAS, Barberton City Council has reviewed the 2020 Decennial Survey Data provided by the United States Census Bureau and determined that no modifications to the ward boundaries set forth by Barberton Codified Ordinance 206 (Chapter 206: Ward and Boundaries) are necessary.

WHEREAS, Barberton City Council acknowledges the 2020 Decennial Redistricting Data (PL-94-171) as the official dataset provided by the United States Census Bureau for calculating the total population within the City of Barberton and within the current ward boundaries outlined in Chapter 206 of the Codified Ordinances for the City of Barberton.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That Barberton City Council acknowledges the Decennial Census Survey results for 2020 provided by the United States Census Bureau and accepts the current ward boundaries as sufficient and that no modification to Chapter 206 of the Barberton Codified Ordinances is required.

SECTION 2. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
