## **ORDINANCE NO. 130-2021**

## TITLE: FOUNDATION GRANT REQUEST SKATE PARK

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE BARBERTON COMMUNITY FOUNDATION, IN AN AMOUNT UP TO \$75,000, FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A SKATE PARK.

WHEREAS, the estimated cost of the project is \$150,000, and

**WHEREAS**, the request is up to \$75,000 match or 50% of the construction cost, whichever is lower, from the Barberton Community Foundation, and

**WHEREAS,** private donations to be collected and held by the Barberton Community Foundation in an established Foundation Industrial Skate Park Fund, and

WHEREAS, the skate park to be named "Foundation Industrial Skate Park," and

**WHEREAS**, when funds raised to complete project, the total shall transfer to the City of Barberton with earmark, and

WHEREAS, request will expire December 31, 2022, and

WHEREAS, the Barberton Community Foundation portion can be from other grans acquired on their own accord and any source deemed available, and

**WHEREAS**, the Foundation Industrial Skate Park Fund to stay in existence in perpetuity for donations to continue to fund all maintenance, insurance, repairs, and any and all costs associated with the skate park.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

- **SECTION 1.** That Council hereby approves the submission of a grant application to the Barberton Community Foundation, in the amount up to Seventy-Five Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$75,000.00) for the construction of a skate park.
- **SECTION 2.** That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

**SECTION 3.** That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
