TITLE: TRANSFER OF FUNDS – STORMWATER

AN ORDINANCE TRANSFERRING \$50,000 FROM THE STORMWATER CAPITAL BUDGET TO THE STORMWATER OPERATIONAL BUDGET IN ORDER TO ASSIST RESIDENTS WHO WERE AFFECTED BY THE STORM ON JULY 10, 2013, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, these funds will be utilized for removal of flood damaged materials, flood clean-up, inspections, assessments and repair/replacement of flood-damaged mechanical systems.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That Council hereby authorizes that Fifty Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$50,000.00) be transferred from the Stormwater Capital Budget to the Stormwater Operational Budget in order to assist residents who were affected by the storm on July 10, 2013.

SECTION 2. That the Director of Finance is hereby directed to draw his warrants in payment thereof.

SECTION 3. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, in order to have funds available, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
