

ORDINANCE NO. 132-2019

**TITLE: ENTER INTO AGREEMENT
CITY OF AKRON**

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, TO ENTER INTO AN ACCESS AND MAINTENANCE SHARING AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF AKRON FOR PROPOSED TRAFFIC SIGNALIZATION AT THE INTERSECTION OF GRAND BOULEVARD AND E. STATE STREET (ROMIG ROAD RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT), AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, under this agreement, the City of Akron will design, construct, and perform ongoing annual maintenance on the newly constructed signal.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to enter into an access and maintenance sharing agreement with the City of Akron for proposed traffic signalization at the intersection of Grand Boulevard and E. State Street (Romig Road reconstruction project).

SECTION 2. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, in order for the reason of project timeliness, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
