WHEREAS, on October 27, 2016 a student in the 8th Grade at Barberton Middle School were on a class trip to Washington D.C. to learn about our great nation's history; and

WHEREAS, as the students and chaperones were in the Lincoln Memorial one of the students fell to the floor and went into cardiac arrest right at the foot of the Great Emancipator himself; and

WHEREAS, without hesitation or delay the chaperones immediately started to perform emergency live saving measures, including CPR when the student's pacemaker did not get the heart going again; and

WHEREAS, the chaperones called 9-1-1, made the scene safe and counseled and kept the other students calm and quiet; and

WHEREAS, the student's heart was re-started by the CPR and she was able to be rushed to a local medical facility where she was admitted. During this time, the chaperones were in touch with her parents back in Barberton and stayed with the student until her parents could arrive; and

WHEREAS, without each of these chaperones timely, dutiful, caring and heroic actions, a tragedy was averted; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Council of the City of Barberton hereby honors and gives public recognition to SRO Shannon Davis, School Nurse Wendy Ray, Principal Joyce Walker and Teachers Jacob Palidar, Jordan Hardwick and Amanda Cline for saving an 8th graders life when she dropped in the Lincoln Memorial with a heart condition on the school field trip.
