

ORDINANCE NO. 134-2017

**TITLE: 2018 BIDS AND CONTRACTS
YEAR'S REQUIREMENTS FOR MATERIALS AND SERVICES**

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE OR THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND/OR ENTER INTO CONTRACTS IN 2018, COVERING THE YEAR'S REQUIREMENTS FOR MATERIALS AND SERVICES USED IN THE ORDINARY AND DAILY OPERATION OF THE MUNICIPAL DEPARTMENTS IN THE CITY OF BARBERTON, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of
Barberton, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Director of Public Service or the Director of Public Safety is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for bids and/or enter into contracts with the “lowest and/or best” bidder, as determined and awarded by the Board of Control, covering the year’s requirements for materials and services used in the ordinary and daily operation of the municipal departments in the City of Barberton, including but not limited to:

Asphaltic concrete
Gasoline and diesel fuel
Limestone
Tires and automotive supplies
Wastewater Treatment supplies (miscellaneous)
Water and Wastewater sludge removal
Water Distribution supplies (miscellaneous)
Water Treatment supplies (miscellaneous)

SECTION 2. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, for the reason that it concerns the efficient operation of the City and because the City needs the immediate authority to purchase some of the foregoing materials and services, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
