TITLE: AMENDING BARBERTON CODIFIED ORDINANCES CHAPTER 351: PARKING GENERALLY

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 351.05 "NIGHT PARKING OF COMMERCIAL / RECREATIONAL VEHICLES IN RESIDENTIAL DISTRICTS," AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That Council hereby amends Section 351.05 "Night Parking of Commercial Vehicles in Residential Districts" by showing said amendments with a strikethrough for any deletions and **bold** for any additions to read as follows:

 $351.05\ \mbox{NIGHT}$ PARKING OF COMMERCIAL / **RECREATIONAL** VEHICLES IN RESIDENTIAL DISTRICTS

No person shall park a school bus, commercial tractor, agricultural tractor, truck of more than a one-ton capacity, bus, trailer, semitrailer, pole trailer, or moving van, **travel trailer**, **boat**, or **recreational vehicle** on any street or highway within the residential districts of the city between one hour after sunset and one hour before sunrise.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

SECTION 2. That is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, for the reason that this transfer can be made in a timely manner and before the end of the year, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
