## **ORDINANCE NO. 134-2023**

## TITLE: APPROPRIATION FIRE DEPARTMENT

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$1,383.43 FROM THE UNAPPROPRIATED ITEM OF THE GENERAL FUND TO THE FIRE DEPARTMENT'S OPERATING BUDGET, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

**WHEREAS**, the Barberton Fire Department has received \$1,383.43 from Noble Oil Services; and,

**WHEREAS**, this is a reimbursement for items used in the Tuscarawas River oil spill; and,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

**SECTION 1.** That the sum of One Thousand Three Hundred Eighty-Three Dollars and Fourth-Three Cents (\$1,383.43) is hereby appropriated from the Unappropriated Item of the General Fund to the Fire Department's Operating Budget.

**SECTION 2.** That the Director of Finance is hereby directed to draw his warrants in payment thereof.

**SECTION 3.** That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of it's committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

**SECTION 4.** That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, in order to purchase replacement equipment in a timely manner, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after it's passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
