SECTION 2. That the December 31 unencumbered appropriations for all line items within the General Fund be reduced to \$0.00.

SECTION 3. That appropriations and estimated revenues for in-kind payments for grants and and loans be adjusted by the Finance Director at December 31st to adhere to budget commission requirements. These payments are made by state grantor/loan agencies directly to contractors and are out of the control of the City.

SECTION 4. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, and for the reason that it concerns the efficient operation of the City and shall, therefore, be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
