ORDINANCE NO. 139-2012

TITLE: APPROPRIATION
NATIONAL GUARD ARMORY TANK BARN

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$7,500 FROM THE UNAPPROPRIATED ITEM OF THE STORMWATER MANAGEMENT FUND TO THE STORMWATER MANAGEMENT FUND OPERATING BUDGET, FOR AN EVALUATION OF THE FORMER NATIONAL GUARD ARMORY TANK BARN TO BE USED FOR STORMWATER VEHICLES AND EQUIPMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the sum of Seven Thousand Five Hundred Dollars and No Cents (\$7,500.00) is hereby appropriated from the Unappropriated Item of the Stormwater Management Fund to the Stormwater Management Fund Operating Budget, for an evaluation of the former National Guard Armory Tank Barn to be used to provide a covered area for Stormwater vehicles and equipment.

SECTION 2. That the Director of Finance is hereby directed to draw his warrants in payment thereof.

SECTION 3. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, and for the reason that the funds are needed as soon as possible in order to proceed with this project in a timely manner, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
