

ORDINANCE NO. 139-2023

**TITLE: CHANGE ORDER
PERRIN ASPHALT AND CONCRETE**

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A CHANGE ORDER FOR ADDITIONAL ROAD PAVEMENT RELATED TO EAST HUSTON SEWER, IN AN INCREASED AMOUNT OF \$59,700 WITH PERRIN ASPHALT AND CONCRETE (ORDINANCE NO. 69-2023), AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Perrin Asphalt and Concrete previously was awarded the resurfacing program contract; and,

WHEREAS, this change order will allow us to resurface the road where the storm sewer work was done; and,

WHEREAS, the change order will allow Perrin Asphalt and Concrete to resurface the road using bid quantities and pricing and will be an increase of \$59,700 to the already approved cost of the road program; and,

WHEREAS, the initial ordinance allowed for a base bid cost of \$1,248,703; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That a change order for the sum of Fifty-Nine Thousand Seven Hundred Dollars and No Cents (\$59,700.00) with Perrin Asphalt and Concrete is hereby authorized for additional road pavement related to East Huston Sewer.

SECTION 2. That the Director of Finance is hereby directed to draw his warrants in payment thereof.

SECTION 3. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, for the reason that it is necessary to authorize a change order for additional funds in a timely manner so work can begin immediately, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
