TITLE: APPROPRIATION LOCAL CORONAVIRUS RELIEF FUND

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$3,328.00 FROM THE UNAPPROPRIATED ITEM OF THE LOCAL CORONAVIRUS RELIEF FUND TO THE OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE BUDGET OF THE LOCAL CORONAVIRUS RELIEF FUND, APPROPRIATING \$18,156.00 FROM THE UNAPPROPRIATED ITEM OF THE LOCAL CORONAVIRUS RELIEF FUND TO THE CAPITAL BUDGET OF THE LOCAL CORONAVIRUS RELIEF FUND, AND APPROPRIATING \$909,251.67 FROM THE UNAPPROPRIATED ITEM OF THE LOCAL CORONAVIRUS RELIEF FUND TO THE PERSONNEL SERVICE BUDGET OF THE LOCAL CORONAVIRUS RELIEF FUND, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the sum of Three Thousand Three Hundred Twenty-Eight Dollars and No Cents (\$3,328.00) is hereby appropriated rom the Unappropriated Item of the Local Coronavirus Relief Fund to the Operation and Maintenance Budget of the Local Coronavirus Relief Fund, Eighteen Thousand One Hundred Fifty-Six Dollars and No Cents (\$18,156.00) is hereby appropriated from the Unappropriated Item of the Local Coronavirus Relief Fund to the Capital Budget of the Local Coronavirus Relief Fund, and Nine Hundred Nine Thousand Two Hundred Fifty-One Dollars and Sixty-Seven Cents (\$909,251.67) is hereby Appropriated from the Unappropriated Item of the Local Coronavirus Relief Fund to the Personnel Service Budget of the Local Coronavirus Relief Fund.

SECTION 2. That the Director of Finance is hereby directed to draw his warrants in payment thereof.

SECTION 3. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, for the reason to get the expenses already paid reclassified and get the future expenses charged to this fund, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
