A RESOLUTION BY THE BARBERTON CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF **ADOPT** BARBERTON TO THE **SUMMIT COUNTY SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT PLAN** \mathbf{BY} THE **SUMMIT/AKRON SOLID** WASTE MANAGEMENT **AUTHORITY DBA** REWORKS FOR THE CITY BARBERTON.

WHEREAS, the City of Barberton is located within the Summit/Akron Solid Waste Management Authority; and

WHEREAS, the Summit/Akron Solid Waste Management Authority Board of Trustees prepared and adopted a final draft of the Solid Waste Management Plan in accordance with Ohio Revised Code Sections 3734.53, 3734.54, and 3734.55; and

WHEREAS, the Summit/Akron Solid Waste Management Authority has provided access to a copy of the draft of the Solid Waste Plan to Barberton City Council via website (www.summitreworks.com) posting on October 27, 2020; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to R.C. 3734.55(B), Council shall approve or disapprove the draft plan within ninety days after receiving a copy of it.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Barberton City Council:

- **SECTION 1.** The Barberton City Council hereby adopts the Summit/Akron Solid Waste Management Authority Solid Waste Management Plan, a copy of which is attached and made a part of this ordinance
- **SECTION 2.** That the Clerk be, and is hereby, directed to send a copy of this ordinance to Marcie Kress, Executive Director of the Summit/Akron Solid Waste Management Authority at 2711 W. Market St., Unit 13620, Fairlawn, OH 44333 or emailed to planner@summitreworks.com
- **SECTION 3.** That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.
- **SECTION 4.** That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, for the reason that this action must be taken within 90 days after receipt of a draft copy of the Plan, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
