ORDINANCE NO. 143-2013

**TITLE: SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS
2012 SIDEWALK REPLACEMENT PROGRAM**

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE DIRECTOR OF FINANCE OF THE CITY OF BARBERTON TO CERTIFY TO THE SUMMIT COUNTY AUDITOR SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS AGAINST CERTAIN PROPERTIES LOCATED WITHIN THE CITY, UNDER THE 2012 SIDEWALK REPLACEMENT PROGRAM, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Barberton, under the authority of Ordinance No. 167-2009, has spent monies to repair damaged sidewalks abutting properties located within the City; and

WHEREAS, under Ordinance No. 9-1995, the property owner has the option of paying the invoice or having the City certify the unpaid invoice to the County Auditor; and

WHEREAS, certain property owners have chosen the option of having the City certify their unpaid invoice to the County Auditor to be placed on their tax duplicate.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Director of Finance of the City of Barberton certify to the Summit County Auditor, special assessments on the following attached list of properties for sidewalk replacement through the 2012 Sidewalk Replacement Program offered by the City.

SEE ATTACHED LIST OF PROPERTIES.

SECTION 2. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, for the reason that time is of the essence due to a deadline for certification, and the ordinance shall, therefore, be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
