

ORDINANCE NO. 149-2015

**TITLE: APPROPRIATION/TRANSFER
BUILDING DEPARTMENT**

AN ORDINANCE REDUCING THE BUILDING DEPARTMENT PERSONAL SERVICES BUDGET BY \$38,000 BY APPROPRIATING \$38,000 FROM THE UNAPPROPRIATED ITEM OF THE GENERAL FUND TO THE GENERAL FUND TRANSFER BUDGET, TRANSFERRING \$38,000 FROM THE GENERAL FUND CASH BALANCE TO THE STREET OPERATING FUND AND APPROPRIATING \$38,000 FROM THE UNAPPROPRIATED ITEM OF THE STREET OPERATING FUND TO THE STREET OPERATING FUND CAPITAL BUDGET TO PURCHASE A NEW PORTABLE ASPHALT HAULER AND A NEW BUCKET FOR THE DEPARTMENT'S FRONT END LOADER, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the sum of Thirty Eight Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$38,000.00) is hereby appropriated from the unappropriated item of the General Fund to the General Fund Transfer Budget. Transferring Thirty Eight Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$38,000.00) from the General Fund Cash Balance to the Street Operating Fund and appropriating Thirty Eight Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$38,000.00) from the unappropriated item of the Street Operating Fund to the Street Operating Fund Capital Budget to purchase a new portable asphalt hauler and a new bucket for the department's front end loader.

SECTION 2. That the Director of Finance is hereby directed to draw his warrants in payment thereof.

SECTION 3. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, and for the reason that the funds are needed as soon as possible, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
