ORDINANCE NO. 149-2017

TITLE: APPROPRIATION FIRE DEPARTMENT

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$5,775 FROM THE FIRE DEPARTMENT GRANT FUND TO THE FIRE DEPARTMENT OPERATING BUDGET, DUE TO A GRANT FROM A STATE OF OHIO EMS GRANT AND WILL BE USED TO PURCHASE EMS EQUIPMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the sum of Five Thousand Seven Hundred Seventy-Five Dollars and No Cents (\$5,775.00) is hereby appropriated from Fire Department Grant Fund to the Fire Department Operating Budget, due to a grant from the State of Ohio EMS to be used for the purchase EMS equipment.

SECTION 2. That the Director of Finance is hereby directed to draw his warrants in payment thereof.

SECTION 3. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, for the reason that funds need to be available in this year's budget, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
