RESOLUTION NO. 153-2014

**TITLE: ENTER INTO CONTRACT – ODOT
WOOSTER ROAD NORTH**

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BARBERTON AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (ODOT) FOR WOOSTER ROAD NORTH, (PID 98365), AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

The following is a resolution enacted by the City of Barberton of Summit County, Ohio, hereinafter referred to as the Local Public Agency (LPA).

SECTION 1. Project Description.

WHEREAS, the STATE has identified the need for the described project:

SUM / Wooster Road North.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City of Barberton of Summit County, Ohio.

SECTION 2. Consent Statement.

Being in the public interest, the LPA gives consent to the Director of Transportation to complete the above described Project.

SECTION 3. Cooperation Statement.

The LPA shall cooperate with the Director of Transportation in the above described project as follows:

The LPA agrees to participate in the cost of construction within the City limits at twenty percent (20%) total cost.

The LPA further agrees to pay Ohio Hundred Percent (100%) of the cost of those features requested by the LPA which are determined by the State and Federal Highway Administration to be unnecessary for the Project.

The LPA further agrees that change orders and extra work contracts required to fulfill the construction contracts shall be processed as needed. The State shall not approve a change order or extra work contract until it first gives notice, in writing, to the LPA. The LPA shall contribute its share of the cost of these items in accordance with other sections herein.

The LPA further agrees to pay One Hundred Percent (100%) of the cost to install and/or curb ramps at all necessary intersections to ensure compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act.

SECTION 4. Utilities and Right-of-Way Statement.

The LPA agrees to acquire and/or make available to ODOT, in accordance with current State and Federal regulations, all necessary right-of-way required for the described Project. The LPA also understands that right-of-way costs include eligible utility costs.

The LPA agrees to be responsible for all utility accommodation, relocation and reimbursement and agrees that such accommodation, relocations and reimbursements shall comply with current provisions of 23 CFR 645 and the ODOT Utilities Manual.
