## **ORDINANCE NO. 156-2012**

TITLE: DISPOSAL OF UNSAFE VEHICLES POLICE DEPARTMENT

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE POLICE CHIEF, OR HIS DESIGNEE, TO SCRAP TEN (10) VEHICLES DEEMED TO BE NO LONGER NEEDED FOR ANY MUNICIPAL PURPOSE AND UNFIT AND UNSAFE FOR DISPOSAL IN ANY OTHER MANNER, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

**SECTION 1.** That Council hereby authorizes the Police Chief, or his designee, to scrap the following ten (10) vehicles deemed to be no longer needed for any municipal purpose and unfit and unsafe for disposal in any other manner (per Section 4513.62 of the Ohio Revised Code), by selling as scrap to the business giving the highest rate of return:

**SECTION 2.** That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

**SECTION 3.** That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, for the reason that any property deemed unsafe needs to be disposed of as soon as possible, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
