TITLE: REPEAL OF ORDINANCE NO. 95-2016 ENTER INTO LEASE AGREEMENT

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 95-2016 THAT AUTHORIZED THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A LEASE AGREEMENT WITH SUMMA HEALTH SYSTEMS FOR A SECTION OF TUSCORA PARK FOR HOSPITAL PARKING, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Summa Health Systems is requesting to withdraw their letter of intent of lease a section of Tuscora Park so, Ordinance No. 95-2016 is no longer needed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That Council hereby repeals Ordinance No. 95-2016, an ordinance that authorized and directed the Mayor to execute a Lease Agreement with Summa Health System for a section of Tuscora Park for hospital parking.

SECTION 2. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, for the reason that time is of the essence, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
