

ORDINANCE NO. 160-2016

**TITLE: ENTER INTO CONTRACT
EXPRESS SCRIPTS/MEDICAL MUTUAL OF OHIO**

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT WITH THE PRESCRIPTION ADMINISTRATOR, EXPRESS SCRIPTS/MEDICAL MUTUAL OF OHIO, TO ADMINISTER THE CITY'S SELF-FUNDED PRESCRIPTION PLAN FOR A ONE (1) YEAR PERIOD BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2017 AND EXPIRING DECEMBER 31, 2017, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with the prescription administrator, Express Scripts/Medical Mutual of Ohio, to administer the City's self-funded Prescription Plan for a one (1) year period beginning January 1, 2017 and expiring December 31, 2017.

SECTION 2. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 3. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, and for the reason that it concerns the efficient operation of the City because the current contract with Caremark will expire on February 29, 2000, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall, therefore, be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
