

ORDINANCE NO. 162-2012

**TITLE: APPROPRIATION – FOREST CITY LAND DEVELOPMENT
NEW HAVEN DEVELOPMENT**

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$100,000 FROM THE UNAPPROPRIATED ITEM OF THE F C BARBERTON IMPROVEMENT FUND TO THE F C BARBERTON IMPROVEMENT FUND OPERATING BUDGET, TO BE USED FOR THE NEW HAVEN DEVELOPMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the \$100,000 is due to a negotiated settlement between the City of Barberton and Forest City Land Development; and

WHEREAS, said funds will be used to complete infrastructure projects and repairs in the New Haven Development.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the sum of One Hundred Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$100,000.00) is hereby appropriated from the Unappropriated Item of the Forest City Barberton Improvement Fund to the Forest City Barberton Improvement Fund Operating Budget to complete infrastructure projects and repairs in the New Haven Development.

SECTION 2. That the Director of Finance is hereby directed to draw his warrants in payment thereof.

SECTION 3. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, in order to utilize the funds for New Haven projects as soon as possible, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
