

ORDINANCE NO. 164-2014

TITLE: YEAR END HEALTH CARE FUND ADJUSTMENT

AN ORDINANCE ELIMINATING THE CITY AND EMPLOYEE CONTRIBUTION TO THE HEALTH CARE FUND FOR THE MONTH OF DECEMBER, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Barberton, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That Council hereby approves the elimination of the City and Employee Contribution to the Health Care Fund for the month of December.

SECTION 2. Elimination of the City contribution will allow the City to meet the end of year budget requirements and insure compliance with the minimum fund balance ordinance. Such adjustment shall be non-precedential.

SECTION 3. That the Finance Director is hereby authorized to eliminate the City's and Employee's Contribution for the month of December to the Health Care Fund.

SECTION 4. That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were meetings open to the public in compliance with the law.

SECTION 5. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Barberton and the inhabitants thereof, and for the reason that it concerns the efficient operation of the City, and provided it receives the necessary votes required by the City Charter, shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval; otherwise to be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
